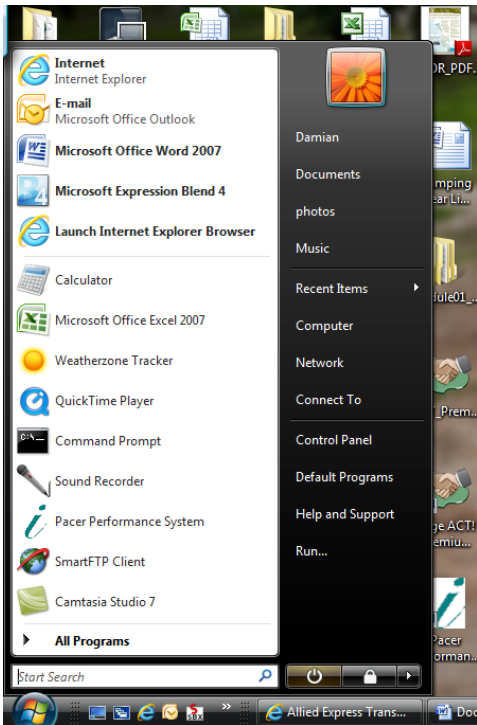
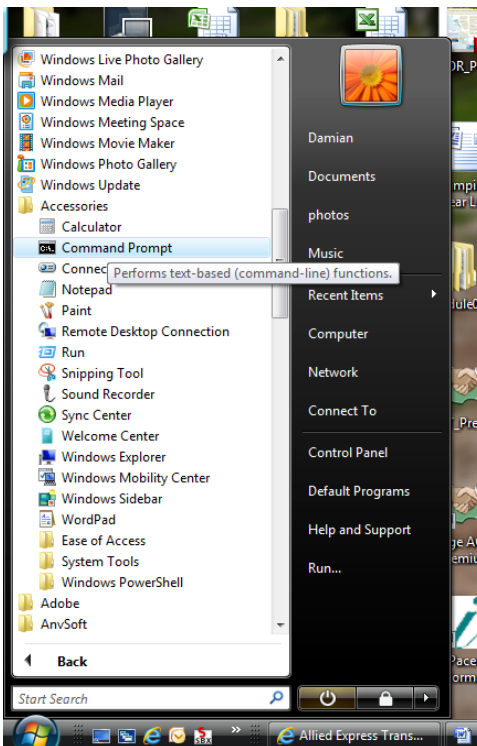


## To record audio files (.wav) to use in the Pacer Performance System Software


go to Start (See Below)



Then click all programs/Accessories/Command Prompt




This will open the command prompt window.

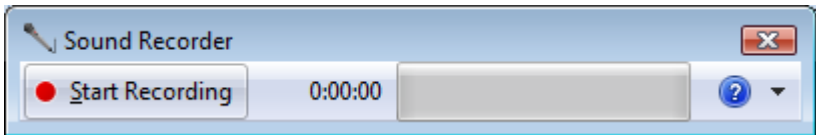
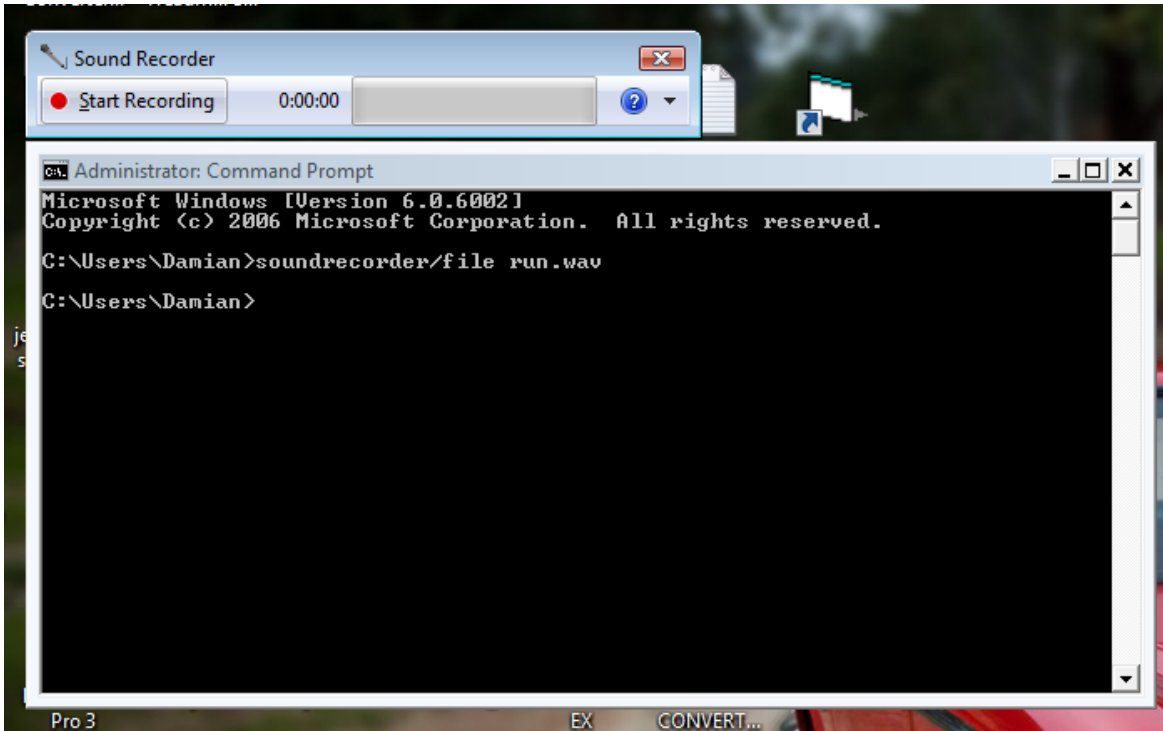
Type in the following text

Soundrecorder/file run.wav (see below)

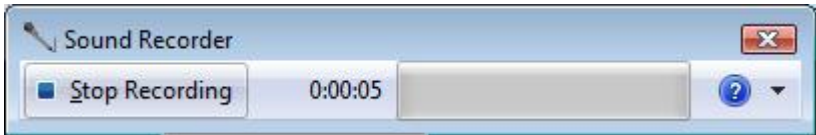

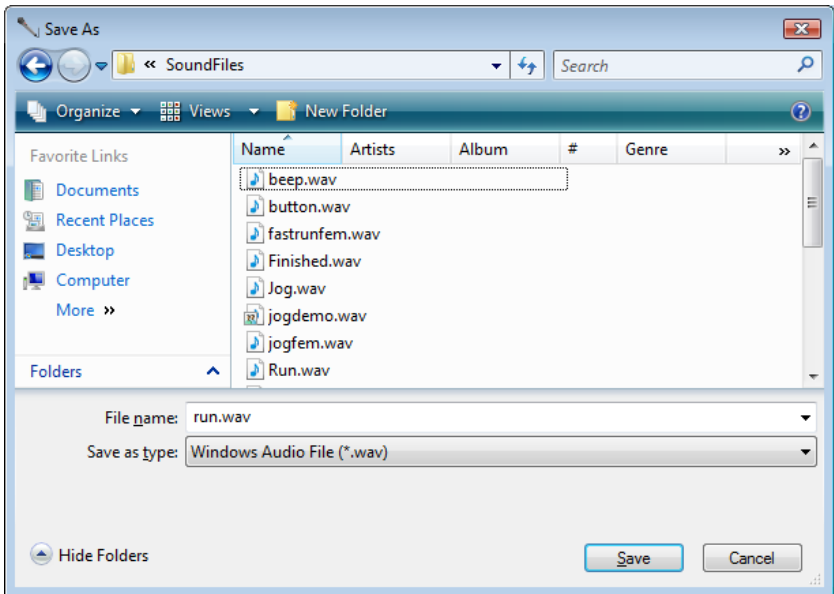
Click enter and the sound recorder will open.



Click 'Start Recording' and record the audio you would like to use in the Pacer Software Program Designer. Try to keep the recording to one or two seconds long.



Click 'Stop Recording'



Rename the filename to suit the recording you have just made.

Then navigate to

(Windows vista and Windows 7) C:/Users/Public/Public Documents/Pacer Performance System/SoundFiles and click 'Save'.

(Windows XP) C:/Documents and Settings/All Users/Documents/Pacer Performance System/SoundFiles and click 'save'.

You can now use that file when creating programs.
